### **Changes to the Family Handbook and Behaviour Policy**

Recently we requested your feedback on areas within our behaviour policy in relation to corrections. I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your valued feedback and your continued support in ensuring your child upholds the core values of resilience, integrity, and courtesy. By strengthening our three – way partnership we will ensure our school is a place where everyone feels welcome and everyone succeeds.

I would like to inform you of some significant changes to the Family Handbook and the Behaviour for Learning Policy that is aimed at fostering a more positive and supportive learning environment for all students.

Effective from Monday 26<sup>th</sup> January 2024, the following modifications will be implemented:

- A lesson removal will now result in a student being issued with two corrections (previously three corrections)
- Students chewing gum will now receive one correction (previously three corrections)
- Trigger points system – to support all students make positive behaviour choices we introduced trigger points at the start of this academic year. More information can be found in the behaviour for learning policy

We believe that these adjustments will contribute to the overall well-being and academic success for our students. We encourage you to review the updated family handbook and behaviour for learning policy. Your cooperation and support in reinforcing these guidelines at home are crucial for their successful implementation.
