Co-Curricular and After-school Clubs Term 2

Dear Families,

At Dixons, we work within our communities to establish joyful, rigorous, high performing schools, which maximise attainment, value diversity, develop character and build cultural capital. In addition to these clubs, more information will be shared about signing up for our free instrumental music lessons and after-school music clubs later in the term.

All co-curriculars will run from 3.15-4.15pm, with the exception of Homework club in the library, which will remain available until 4.45 each day. Students can be collected from the Trinity Rd entrance at the end of the club. In order to stay behind after school, students must either sign up to a regular co-curricular club or attend homework club in the library. Attendance at Homework club can be ad-hoc, but students **must** sign in with the member of staff in the Library to ensure the safeguarding of everyone on site.

Places at some clubs are likely to be limited and will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis (or by ballot). If a student regularly does not attend, they may lose their place. The clubs on offer and places for clubs will be reallocated after the February half-term holidays. Please note, students will not be allowed to re-enter the academy if they have left the building at the end of the day. The academy will be completely closed to students after 4.45. If a student receives a correction, they must attend the correction instead of the club.
