Useful Revision Strategies

Pomodoro Technique

- The Pomodoro Technique is a time management method designed to boost productivity by breaking work into 25-minute, focused intervals - called "pomodoros" - separated by 5-minute breaks.
- Developed in the 1980s by Francesco Cirillo, it uses a timer to help users stay focused and avoid burnout.
- "Pomodoro" means 'tomato' in Italian, and refers to old-fashion kitchen timers often shaped as tomatoes
- If you use your phone as a timer, you have to be self-disciplined to not look at it – if you think you will struggle, buy a cheap timer – maybe even a pomodoro tomato kitchen timer!
- **How to Use the Pomodoro Technique:**
 - **Choose a task:** Select a single task to focus on.
 - **Set a timer:** Set it for 25 minutes.
 - **Work intensely:** Work on the task, uninterrupted, until the timer rings.
 - **Take a short break:** Take a 5-minute break (e.g., stretch, get water).
 - **Repeat:** Repeat the process.
 - **Reset:** After four "pomodoros," take a longer break (15–30 minutes)

Use Flashcards with The Leitner method

- Flashcards should be simple and effective with a key term on one side, and its definition on the other
- Flashcards should not have lots of words on them (just make notes on normal paper for that!)
- All flashcards start in the first box.
- Work with a friend or family member and use your flashcards for quizzing
- When confident with the vocabulary you can move the card into the second box, then the third.
- If you are not confident with the vocabulary it goes back into the first box.
- This uses the idea of spaced repetition.

Mind Maps

1. Write your mind map subject in the centre of your page – choose a sub-topic, never a full unit as otherwise you will almost definitely run out of space!
2. Add key ideas to your mind map by writing their headings on the page and drawing a connecting line between them and your main heading.
3. Use images and key words.
4. Link new content to your current mind map.
5. Use different colours, font or size to highlight important content.
6. Add extra connecting lines and colour coding to link content.

Flip and Fold Method

- Copy one topic from your 100% sheets onto one side of A4 paper
- Put your 100% sheet away
- Fold your A4 paper in half and on one side, create a detailed spider diagram based on your notes
- Fold in half again
- On one side, use your spider diagram to create a detailed key word glossary with definitions
- On the other side, draw visual cues and pictures to represent the topic
