University of Leeds Geography Visit

I am writing to you about an exciting opportunity which has come up in the Geography department. We have been invited to visit the Geography department at the University of Leeds on the 14 January 2026. We feel your child is showing excellent progress in Geography and therefore feel they would benefit from learning more about the subject of Geography beyond Dixons McMillan. The itinerary is as follows:

- **09.00 – 10.00:** Depart Dixons McMillan on school minibus
- **10.00 – 10.20:** Arrival and welcome at University of Leeds, including intro to the Undergraduate Programmes
- **10.20 – 10.30:** Student experience talk (Ambassadors)
- **10.30 – 11.15:** Ambassador led tour of Geography at Leeds and the wider university
- **11.15 – 11.45:** Two x 15 min taster lectures – one BA-focused, one BSc-focused
- **11.45 – 12.00:** Informal chat with students about Geography A-Level and concluding comments.

There is no cost for this trip and students should arrive to school at normal time wearing school uniform. Normal academy expectations apply and students will be checked for mobile phones before leaving. As always, a full risk assessment will be completed before the day to ensure students are safe throughout the visit.
