

Remote Learning – What to do

1. Ensure you have a quiet place to work, where you can concentrate, away from distractions
2. Gather the equipment you will need for your day as you would do at school, you will need some paper to write on in addition to your usual equipment (black pen, green pen, pencil, ruler)

4. Open your email from your Head of Year, with your remote learning timetable
